## Leave No Trace 101 – Awareness

- This 3-4-hour class is designed to help youth and adults at all program levels to understand the general principles of Leave No Trace and how to apply them in the BSA outdoor program. It is also designed to give adults the confidence to assess youth understanding and skills when signing off on scout rank requirements or Venturing award requirements.

## Leave No Trace Trainer Course

- This 16-hour, overnight course trains adults and youth ages 14 and up to better serve their Units. It is recommended training for the *Outdoor Ethics Guide* troop junior leadership position. It is also highly recommended for camp staff, members of the council and district outdoor program and training teams.

## Tread Trainer Course
