

Is Your Pack going to be a Family Pack??

Effective June 11, the Family Pack Pilot Program became a formal part of Cub Scouts. Girls may now join any Cub Scout Packs that have decided to be a Family Pack.

In order to accept girls, the pack must “Opt-In.” To do so:

- One of the Key 3 must login into my.scouting.org
- From MENU select the UNIT you want to update
- Select ORGANIZATION MANAGER
- Once in organization manager select the SETTINGS tab scroll all the way down

As a reminder, before opting-in, the Charter Organization must be consulted with, and agree that the Pack indeed is a Family Pack.
