### **High Adventure Programs at Base Camp:**

Rock Climbing: Our Advanced Climbing Instructors have several climbs set up for you and your skill level. Trained adult spotters and belayers will assist you in climbing and rappelling the rock with harnesses and helmets.

COPE: The high ropes course requires teamwork to cross the "Jellyfish" forty feet in the air. Get an aerial tour of Base Camp while pushing your limits and developing valuable skills working as a team.
