Directions

From I-93N Take I-93N to Exit 15 in Concord, New Hampshire. Take I-393 East to Route 4 East. Take Route 4 East to the traffic rotary in Epsom, about 8 miles from I-93. Continue East on Route 4 onto Northwood, NH. Turn Right onto Blakes



Hill Road, about 7 miles from the rotary. The camp entrance is approximately 1 1/2 miles on the right.

From Route 125 Take Route 125 North into New Hampshire, though Plaistow. Kingston, Brentwood and into Lee, NH. From the traffic rotary in Lee, NH, take Route 4 West (3/4 around the rotary). Follow Route 4 West for approximately 13 miles to Blake Hill Road in Northwood, NH. Turn left onto Blakes Hill Road. The camp entrance is approximately 1 1/2 miles on the right.

From I-95 Take I-95N to exit 4 (the Route 4/Route 16 split) in New Hampshire. Follow Route 4W/16N for 5.7 miles to exit 6W - Route 4 west. Follow Route 4 west for about 22 miles to Blake Hill Road in Northwood, NH. Turn left onto Blakes Hill Road. The camp entrance is approximately 1 1/2 miles on the right.

Program

The program will have the patrols moving from station to station to get opportunities to shoot .22s, shoot archery, throw tomahawks, use sling shots, and other activities.

Cooking Contest

All patrols are invited to take part in our cooking contest. Bring some meat to be cooked with other ingredients that can be purchased at the Fur Trapper General Store. The ingredients available will not be advertised, but will be learned about upon entering the store. Each patrol must pay \$3.00 for their ingredients.

Check-in

All units must check upon arrival. Headquarters will be at the Boathouse. All units must submit a roster of all participants. Please, no arrivals before 5:00 PM.

Parking

Parking will be not allowed in camping areas, only in the designated lots. As always, keep the number of vehicles that you bring to a minimum.

For each vehicle, units will be given a form on which will show their unit number on and are asked to put this form on the dashboard of each vehicle. This will aid event staff in contacting the driver should the car need to be moved or any other problem arises.

Camping Areas

Camping areas will not be assigned. However, some areas will be reserved for program.



Unit Campfires

There is wood that can be used for fires; NH law does not allow firewood to be brought into NH from other states. All units must bring buckets for use as fire buckets. Campfires must be in designated locations.

Trash

Units are required to take all trash out of camp with them.
