#### Theme:

'Pocket Guide to the Galaxy'

This year's Spring Camporee will focus on using your smart phone and apps at stations to resolve real world situations that a scout my come across. Smart phones as a new basic essential. The Scouts will be challenged to accomplish tasks with limited resources and limitless imagination.

#### **Morning Stations:**

- At each station, scouts will be given a scenario with a problem for them to resolve or an action to undertake.
- Scouts are required to solve the problem using their own abilities and training.
- Scouts are given points based not only on accomplishment of the problem, but on patrol spirit, team unity, and other scout qualities.

## **General Information**

- <u>CHECK-IN</u>: Units must check in upon arrival, Friday evening or Saturday morning. Submit a patrol roster of all participants. Patrols should be made up of 6-10 Scouts. All units are responsible for their members' medical forms.
- <u>PARKING:</u>

Parking allowed at service center parking lot.

Vehicles may enter campsite to load/unload.

Troop trailers allowed to remain at campsite.

## • <u>CAMPING:</u>

Camping allowed in designated camping areas only. Camping is not assigned.
