to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law; to help other people at all times; to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight."

## The Scout Law

"A Scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent."

In addition to following the Scout Oath and Scout Law – we require all Scouts and their families to adhere to the following Code of Conduct for all Den Meetings and Scout Activities:

## Expectations for Scouts:

- Always be on time. Bear Den meetings will start promptly at 6:30 pm, unless otherwise specified. Notify your Den Leader if you will be unable to attend a Den or Pack activity.
- Wear the proper uniform with PRIDE clean, neat, and complete to all Scouting events.
  - Listen and pay attention. In response to the "wolf ears" signal, silently return the sign; always follow Akela.
