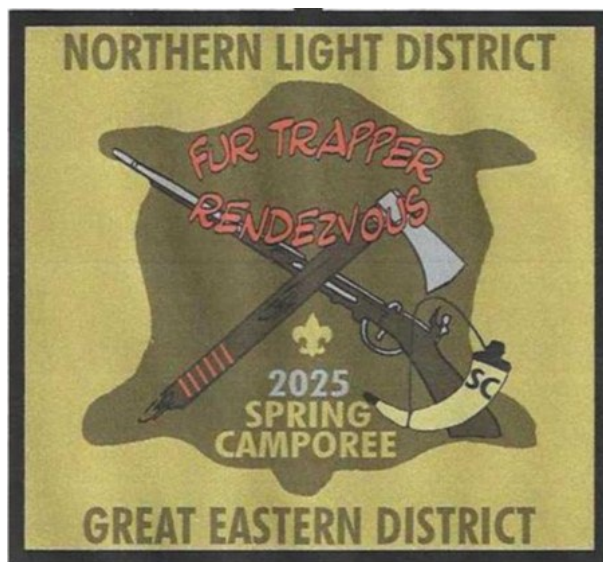

Program

The program will have the patrols moving from station to station to get opportunities to shoot .22s, shoot archery, throw tomahawks, use sling shots, and other activities.

Cooking Contest

All patrols are invited to take part in our cooking contest. Bring some protein to be cooked with ingredients provided at the Fur Trapper General Store. The ingredients will not be advertised but will be learned upon entering the store. The unit may use anything they have in their pantry but must include the provided ingredients. All entries must be accompanied by a sheet listing the name of the dish, a list of all the ingredients used, and the cooking method used. The entries may be part of the unit's dinner or a unique dish for the cooking contest. The entries will be judged on taste, cooking techniques, originality, and camporee theme appropriate.

Check-in

All units must check in upon arrival at the Reservation Office. All units must submit a roster of all participants. Please, no arrivals before 5:00 PM on Friday.

Parking

Parking will be not allowed in camping areas, only in the designated parking areas. As always, keep the number of vehicles that you bring to a minimum.

For each vehicle, units will be given a form on which will show their unit number on and are asked to put this form on the dashboard of each vehicle. This will aid event staff in contacting the driver should the car need to be moved or any other problem arises.

Trailers

It is unlikely that trailers will be allowed to be in the camping areas. “Be Prepared” to have to move equipment from the parking area to the campsites. Camp volunteers may be able to assist in moving troop gear.

Camping Areas

Camping areas will be designated and units can tent within those areas. Do not spread out your unit site too much as other units will need space also.



Water

Water will not be available in the campsites. There is a spigot near the Dining Hall for water.

Unit Campfires

There is wood that can be used for fires; NH law does not allow firewood to be brought into NH from other states. All units must bring buckets for use as fire buckets. Campfires must be in designated locations.

Trash

Units are required to take all trash out of camp with them.
